After that, you will visit the Vietnam Museum of Ethnology, which preserves the traditional, material, and spiritual values of the 54 ethnic groups in Vietnam. At the end of this tour, you will stop by Ngoc Son Temple, which is full of fascinating legends.

In the morning, you will be picked up by our tour guide at your hotel. Starting the Hanoi city tour by visiting **Tran Quoc Pagoda**. It is located on the shores of West Lake in Hanoi, is the oldest Buddhist pagoda in Vietnam, continuing to **Ho Chi Minh Mausoleum Complex**. This is the resting place of President Ho Chi Minh, the outstanding leader of the Vietnamese nation. Then you will visit the **Temple of Literature**, known as the earliest educational institutions in Vietnam.

After having lunch at a local restaurant, you will visit **Vietnam Museum of Ethnology** - a place where various handicraft demonstrations and different forms of folk culture from Vietnamese ethnic groups, other regions around the world.

In the afternoon, you will visit **Ngoc Son Temple**. It has been classified as a special national heritage site in Vietnam. Then you will walk to visit the **Ha Noi Old Quarter** with its rich history, vibrant culture, and unique architecture, this ancient part of the city offers a captivating glimpse into the past.
